- Students should be in top 30 percent of the class, scholastically
- Students who have attended a previous conference are not eligible unless selected to return as a junior counselor
- Students do not have to be a Farm Bureau member to attend, but must become one to be eligible to enter the Free Enterprise Speech Contest

If selected, your county Farm Bureau provides you a full scholarship, including room and board, registration, meals, all conference materials and use of university facilities.

GO THE EXTRA MILE

Free enterprise moves our lives. Education gives us the tools. That's why we offer you an additional opportunity to earn scholarships through our Free Enterprise Speech Contest. Open only to those attending the 2020 Youth Leadership Conference, contestants give three local speeches on free enterprise, which must be six to eight minutes in length and verified by your county Farm Bureau. By doing so, you automatically become eligible for the district contest.

Thirteen district winners will compete during the Texas Farm Bureau Leadership Conference in January 2021.

REWARDS ARE SWEET

Students who attend the Youth Leadership Conference are taking the first step to exciting rewards and opportunities. Texas Farm Bureau will offer a unique opportunity for advancement.

Every participant can enter the Free Enterprise Speech Contest in the fall of 2020. This contest will allow select students to earn scholarships to pay for college expenses. Each district winner will receive a \$1,500 scholarship and the opportunity to increase his or her scholarship at the state contest. Four finalists will each have their scholarships increased to \$2,500, a runner-up will have his or her scholarship increased to \$3,000 and the winner of the contest will receive a \$6,000 scholarship. In addition, the six finalists will receive an expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C. during the summer of 2021.

Details about the Free Enterprise Speech Contest and the Washington, D.C. trip will be available during the conference.
