

TEXAS FARM BUREAU CLOVER CASH TEXAS 4-H GRANT PROGRAM

Project Overview:

Texas Farm Bureau's Clover Cash grant program was created to support Texas 4-H programs at the county, district and state levels. These programs should strive to help students understand the importance of advocating for agriculture. Students should also gain an appreciation and better understanding of where their food, fuel and fiber come from. Qualifying projects will provide a hands-on experience for all members involved. Grants may be requested up to \$1,000 at the county level, \$1,500 at the district level and \$2,000 at the state level.

Eligibility Requirements:

- County Extension Agents or Adult Leaders of any county, district or state level 4-H program

Project and Application Guidelines:

- Projects should be based on an agricultural concept. Preference will be given to those projects that are hands-on agricultural learning activities.
- Students must be directly engaged in the educational component.
- A timeline of the project and a list of all community partners must be listed on the application.
- The application must contain a detailed budget with estimated expenses.
- Applications will be accepted from County Extension Agents or Adult Leaders.
- Grant checks will be made payable to an organization, not an individual.

Grant Amounts Available:

- At the state level, three grants of up to \$2,000 each will be awarded
- At the district level, four grants of up to \$1,500 each will be awarded
- At the county level, four grants of up to \$500; four grants of up to \$750; and three grants of up to \$1,000 each will be awarded

Fund Disbursement and Project Reporting:

Successful applicants will receive their funds once winners are announced Aug. 14. Grant recipients will be required to submit a final report electronically and will be due to TFB by Dec. 1, 2020. TFB strongly encourages you to submit photos and/or short video clips in electronic form, as well as appropriate photo releases.
