

Scholarship Requirements Checklist– College Level

Scholarships must be submitted on-line on or before midnight March 5, 2021

Eligibility requirements for all collegiate scholarships

- Applicant must complete questions 1-18
- Applicant must be a member of a Farm Bureau family (*membership must remain in good standing for the duration of the scholarship*)
- Family information (residence, parent/guardian, siblings)
- Collegiate / University information
- Other scholarships (pending or received) / financial assistance
- List percentage of income paying for your education
- List major Agriculture Leadership activities & honors
- List other Leadership activities & honors
- Applicant must upload a copy of the applicant's College Transcript
- Applicant must upload a signed degree plan
- Applicant must upload the SAR (Student Aid Report) page of FAFSA report
- Please upload a portrait of yourself

Eligibility requirements for Young Farmer & Rancher – Enrolled College Students

Total of 3 awarded, valued at \$2,000 each

Scholarship awards will be announced by May 3, 2021

- Applicant must complete questions 1-18
- Must have completed 45 hours of college credit (at the time of application)
- Must be an undergraduate
- Must have a GPA of at least 2.5
- Must intend to pursue a career in agriculture
- Must submit two letters of recommendation

Eligibility requirements for Student Teaching Scholarship

Total of four \$1500 awarded for Fall 2021 Semester

- **This scholarship will be a one-time disbursement payable to your college or university**
- **Scholarship recipients will be announced by May 3, 2021**
- Applicant must complete questions 1-19
- Must be attending a college or university that provides an Agricultural Education degree program, teaching option (ASU, SHSU, SFAU, Sul Ross State, TSU, TAMU College Station, Commerce and Kingsville, Texas State University, TTU, WTAMU)
- Must be a senior Agricultural Education major with the purpose of teaching agriculture
- Must be going into your student teaching semester
- Must download the recommendation form for a University supervisor to complete and email back to youthactivities@txfb.org no later than March 5th. (form found here: [Recommendation Form](#))
- Please upload a picture of yourself

Eligibility requirements for S.M. True, Jr. Agricultural Scholar Award

One scholarship will be awarded valued at \$20,000

Scholarship award will be announced later in May 2021

- Applicant must complete questions 1-18
- Must be a member of Farm Bureau family with continuous membership for at least 3 years at the time of application (*membership must remain in good standing for the duration of the scholarship*)
- Provide two letters of recommendation
 - a. From the county Farm Bureau president of the applicant's membership county, and
 - b. From the dean or head of the agriculture program department of the applicant's college or university
- Must be enrolled, or about to enroll, in an agriculture program major, provide a copy of course work and grades to date of application
- Must be enrolled in a four-year college or university that is (or will be upon receipt of the award) classified as a junior (at least 60 hours of credit completed at the time of application)
- Must be an undergraduate
