# Foreign Ownership of Land

**SB 711:** Relating to the purchase of or other acquisition of title to real property by prohibited foreign actors.

Sen. Perry, Charles (R)

## Summary:

Unlike the other foreign land ownership bills discussed in previous issues of Austin Newsletter, SB 711 does not create a prohibition against "foreign actors" purchasing land in Texas.

Rather, the bill creates a reporting requirement on the part of the buyer if the buyer is an agent of a foreign country considered to be "risk to the national security of the United States."

Each year, the director of National Intelligence conducts an "Annual Threat Assessment." Certain countries are considered risks to national security. If an agent of one of these countries wishes to purchase land in Texas, they must disclose to the seller they are an agent of that country.

Then, the seller may continue with the transaction, or they may terminate the deal. The seller cannot be sued for terminating the transaction.

TFB **supports** SB 711. The bill provides a seller with important information they may consider in determining whether to sell to certain buyers. (TFB 2023 Policy Book: Real Property Rights Section 150, Page 60, Lines 109-110.)
