How It Works:

- 3. Read the book as a class on March 18-22
- 4. Take a picture, tag Texas Farm Bureau on Facebook, Instagram, or Twitter, and use the hashtag #ReadAgBooksTX2024
- 5. Teachers who tag Texas Farm Bureau AND use the hashtag will be entered into a drawing! Winners will be announced on the AITC webpage in April.

**Note: As stated above, this is a K-5 program for Texas teachers. Please do not sign up for this program if your classroom does not meet this criteria.

We highly encourage that you work with your K-5 teachers and facilitate the program with them as to increase agricultural literacy and involve your ag students, but we do ask that those teachers sign up individually.
