

**Collegiate Scholarship Requirements Checklist
Mia Balko Student Teaching Scholarship – Fall 2024**

Scholarships must be submitted on-line on or before 11:59 PM, March 1, 2024

Total of 4 Student Teaching Scholarships awarded, valued at \$1,500 each

- **This scholarship will be a one-time disbursement payable to your college or university**
- **Scholarship recipients will be announced by the end of May 2024**

Eligibility requirements

- Applicant must complete all questions
- Applicant must be a member of a Texas Farm Bureau family (*membership must remain in good standing for the duration of the scholarship*)
- Must be going into your student teaching semester (Fall of 2024)
- Must be a senior Agricultural Education major with the purpose of teaching agriculture
- Must be attending a college or university that provides an agricultural education degree program, teaching option

 - Sam Houston State University
 - Stephen F. Austin University
 - Sul Ross State
 - Tarleton State University
 - Texas A&M University College Station, Commerce or Kingsville
 - Texas State University
 - Texas Tech University
 - West Texas A&M University
- Collegiate / university information
- Other scholarships (submitted or received) / financial assistance
- List percentage of income paying for your education
- List major agriculture leadership activities & honors
- List other leadership activities & honors
- Applicant must upload a copy of their college transcript
- Applicant must upload the FSS (FAFSA Submission Summary) if the FAFSA was submitted
- Applicant must upload a copy of their degree plan with proof of enrollment of student teaching semester
- Must upload the recommendation form, completed and signed by your university supervisor.
