# PROPOSITION 1

## Right to Farm & Ranch **Constitutional Amendment**



- Passed state legislature unanimously
- Passed statewide constitutional amendment with **79%** voter approval
- TFB produced mailers, emails, radio ads, and text messages, as well as purchased signs supporting the campaign
- County Farm Bureaus contributed directly to the campaign, handed out promotional materials, and bought and placed signs on roadways and at polling locations
