(Hint: likes to grow during colder months.)



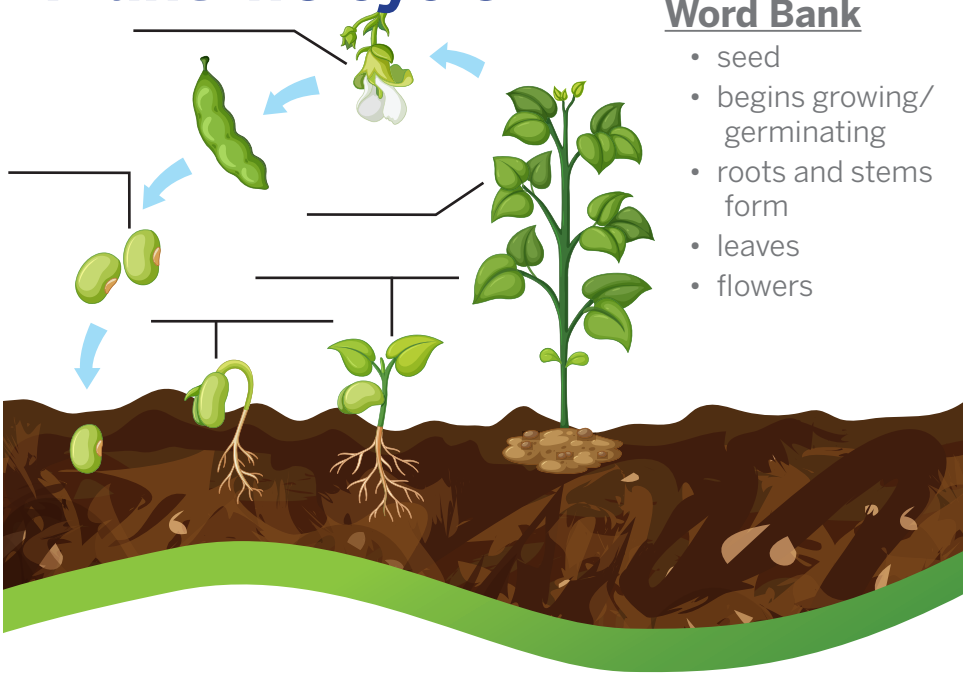

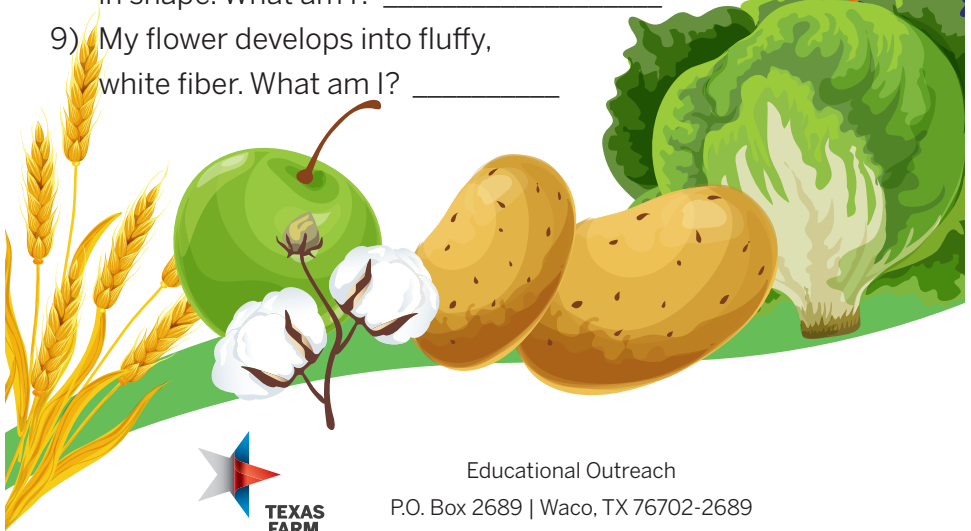
