- All applications must be completed online. Please follow the step-by-step instructions below to access and complete TFB scholarship applications.

 - a. You will enter your TFB member # and zip code to verify
 - b. To find your TFB member #, please refer to your TFB membership renewal notice or if you have TFB Insurance, you can reference your insurance card or statement (You can also contact your local county Farm Bureau)
 - c. Once verified, you will be automatically directed to the Texas Farm Bureau Scholarship portal
 - d. Select "Click Here to Apply"
 - e. You will be directed to the scholarship application portal "Reviewr"

How to Apply - Online via Reviewr (CONTINUED)

- 2. Once on the Reviewr page, click on "Create an Account" or "Login" for return users, found on the right-hand side of the screen. From there, thoroughly read instructions and eligibility requirements provided.
- 3. Select the scholarship you wish to apply for and complete the application.
 - a. If you are applying for more than one scholarship, please follow the instructions displayed at the completion of your first application to apply for another scholarship.
- 4. You will receive an email from the Reviewr system once you have successfully completed and submitted your application(s).

Eligibility and Required Application Documents

- The scholarship applicant must be 1) a Texas Farm Bureau member, OR 2) listed as a dependent of a Texas Farm Bureau member to apply for any TFB scholarship opportunity.
 - o (Note Texas Farm Bureau Membership is a family membership. <u>If listed as a dependent or spouse on the membership</u>, dependents or spouses of Texas Farm Bureau members in good standing are considered to be members (for dependents, only up to age 25). Texas Farm Bureau's membership requirements will apply and govern any determination of membership.)
- Each scholarship has a unique set of eligibility requirements and award criteria. Each scholarship's requirements and award criteria are located on the Texas Farm Bureau Scholarship webpage https://texasfarmbureau.org/youth/scholarship-apps/

- Print application instructions and scholarship requirement and award criteria document(s) prior to filling out the online application.
- · Information is auto saved in Reviewr.
- Applications CANNOT be edited after submission.
- When uploading documents <u>DO NOT</u> include symbols in the file name.
- File Names MUST include applicant name and indicate the document being uploaded.
 Examples: Jane Doe HS Transcript, Jane Doe ACT SAT
- Do not submit your application until:
 - o All questions are answered
 - o All information is correct
 - o All required documents are uploaded
