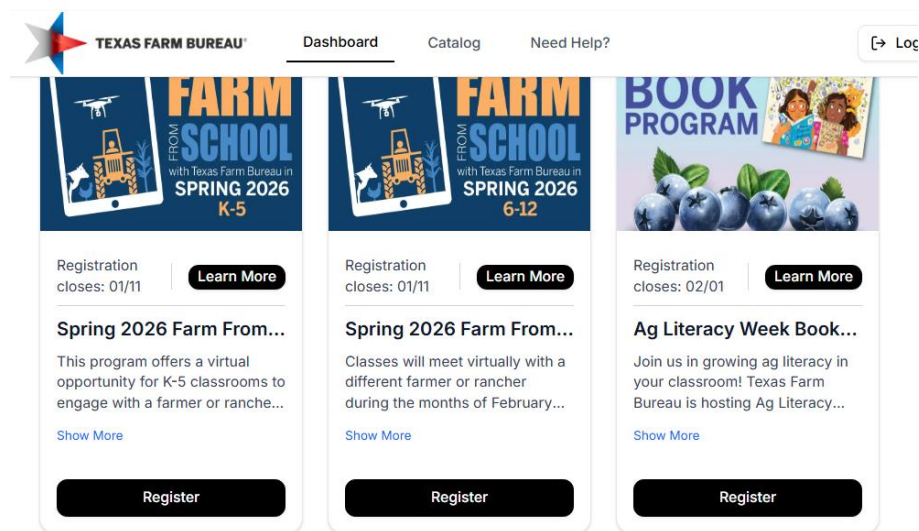
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- e. After completing your registration, you'll receive an email with your access code, which you'll use to log in to your account.
