

# AG LITERACY WEEK

Join us in growing ag literacy in your classroom! Texas Farm Bureau is hosting Ag Literacy Week March 23-27, 2026, in conjunction with National Ag Week. We want your help to inspire students to learn more accurate information about agriculture AND connect it to what they're learning in the classroom.

We're inviting K-5 teachers across the state to join us in increasing agricultural literacy in the classroom by reading an educational, accurate ag book: I love Blueberries By Shannon Anderson.

**The program is FREE.** K-5 public, private, or homeschool educators teaching in a classroom setting in Texas who sign up will receive a free copy of the book and an educator's guide with lessons and activities. Organizations are **not** eligible to register.

## How It Works:

- 1. Sign up by Feb. 2**
- 2. Receive your book and educator's guide in the mail by March 13.**
- 3. Read the book as a class on March 23-27.**
- 4. Take a picture, tag Texas Farm Bureau on Facebook, Instagram, or Twitter, and use the hashtag #ReadAgBooksTX2026.**
- 5. Teachers who tag Texas Farm Bureau AND use the hashtag will be entered into a drawing! Winners will be announced in April.**

**\*\*Note:** As stated above, this is a K-5 program for Texas teachers. Please do not sign up for this program if your classroom does not meet these criteria or if you are not currently located in Texas.

If you're an ag teacher interested in having your ag/FFA students read this book to K-5 classrooms, please have those K-5 teachers sign up individually, so we can communicate with and provide resources directly to them. We highly encourage that you work with your K-5 teachers and facilitate the program with them as to increase agricultural literacy and involve your ag students, but we do ask that those teachers sign up individually.
