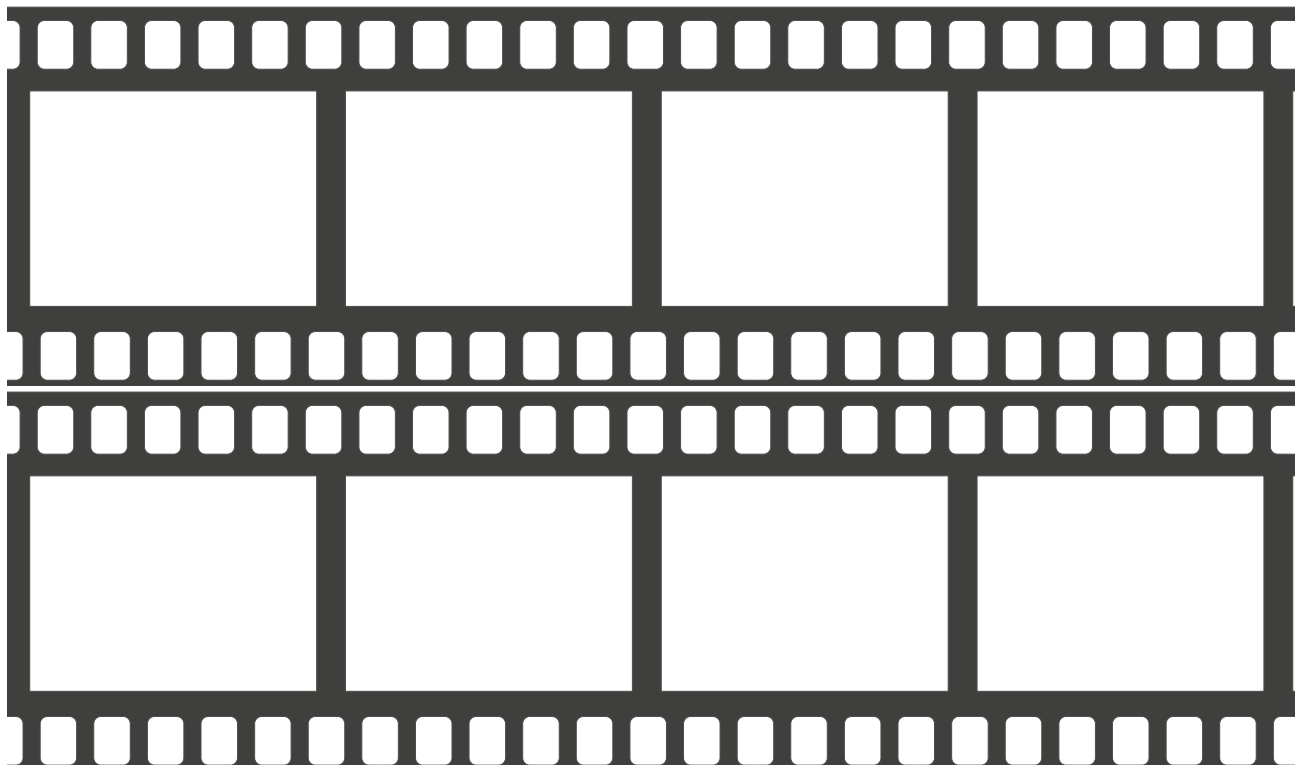

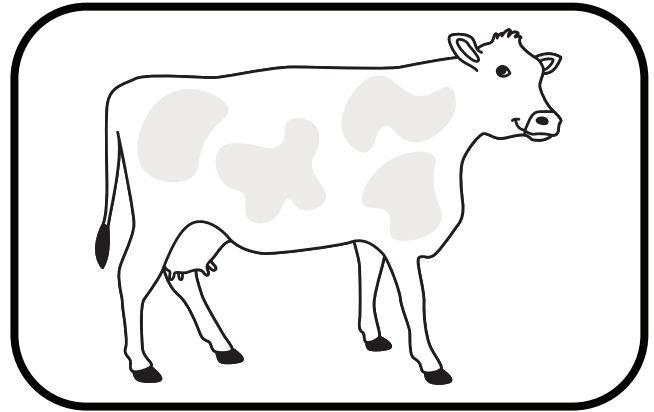
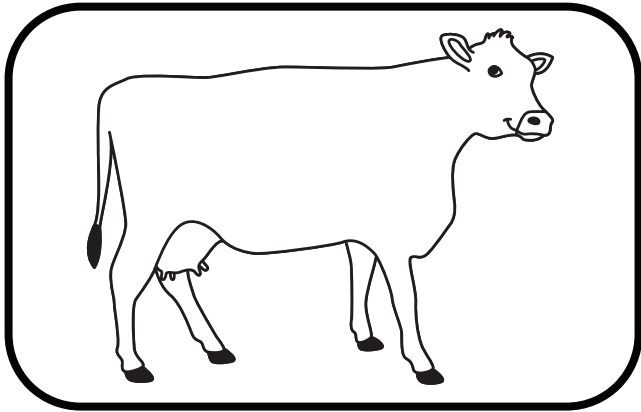
- How many pounds of milk does it take to make 7 pounds of cheese?

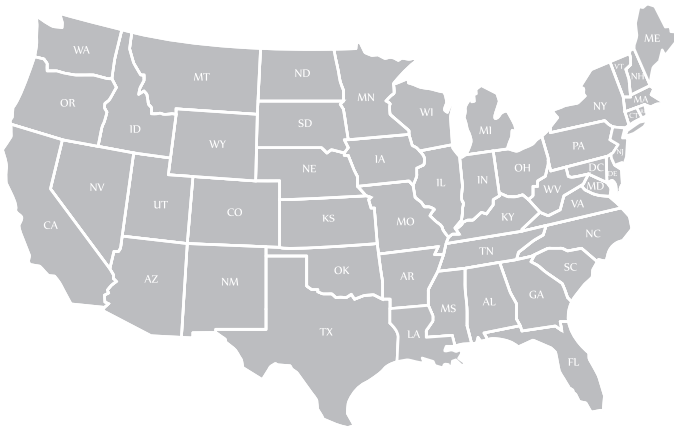

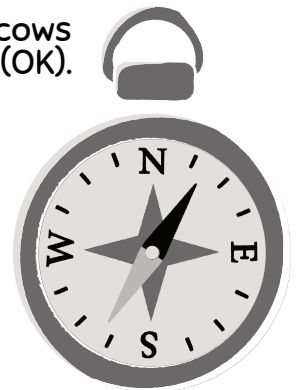
# STATE OF DAIRY:

- ★ This state is located West of Colorado (CO) and ranks 1<sup>st</sup> in dairy production.
- ★ Located up North, this state is known for their cheese production.
- ★ This state had over 675,000 dairy cows in 2025 and is South of Oklahoma (OK).

- ★ This state is the furthest East and produces over 25 billion gallons of milk each year.
- ★ Located Southwest of Arkansas (AR), this state produces 16.9 billion pounds of milk a year.
