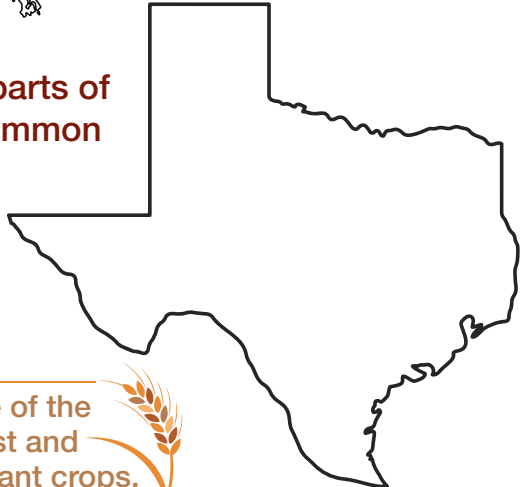


Texas

Color the Panhandle region on the Texas map.



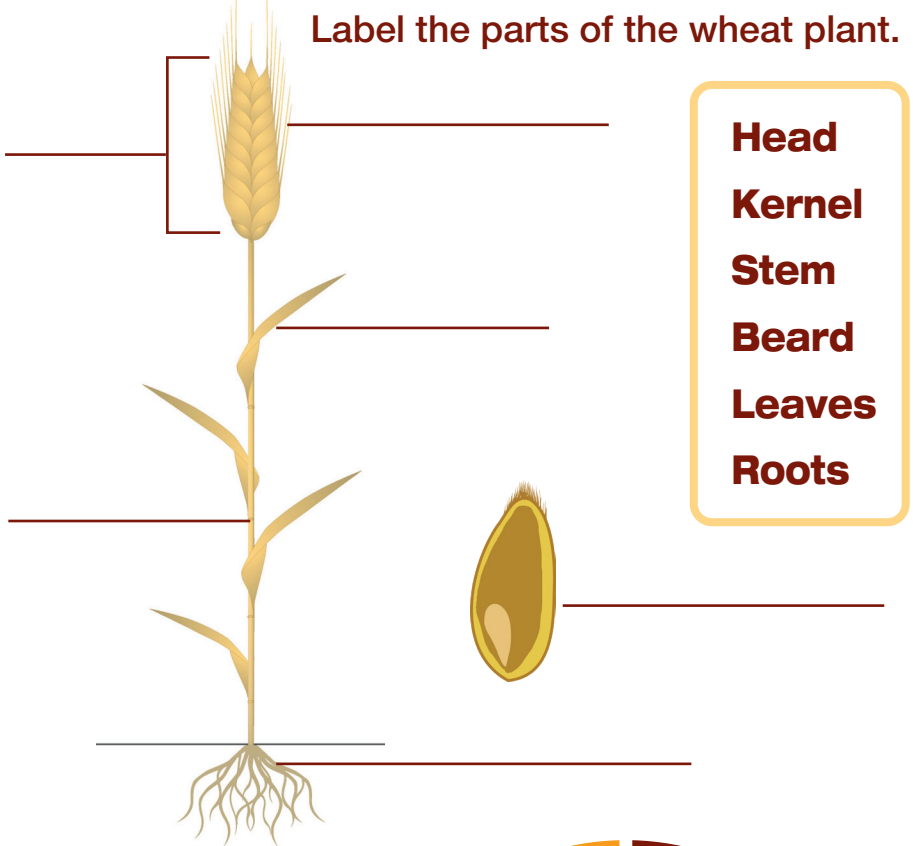

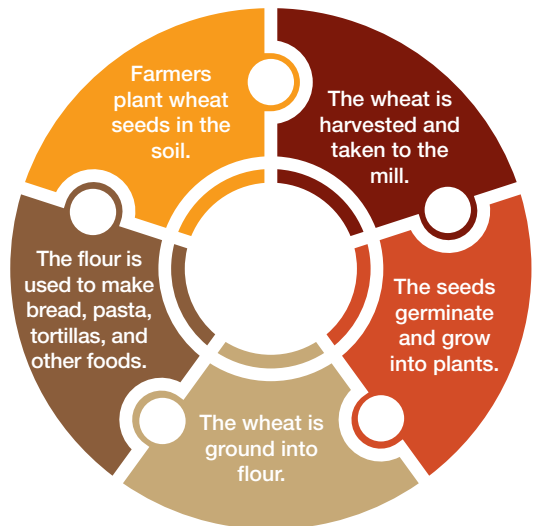
PARTS OF A WHEAT PLANT

Put the steps in the right order by numbering them 1 through 5.



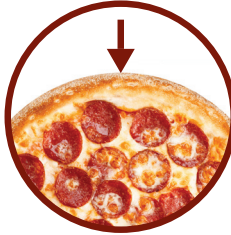
