Program Overview

An internship opportunity with the Texas Farm Bureau (TFB) Doorways to Agriculture (D2A) exhibit that allows undergraduate students to gain experience in agricultural education and public engagement while promoting Texas agriculture. The D2A exhibit utilizes walkthrough trailers with interactive games, live commodity presentations, and videos to engage and educate the many visitors by opening the “doors” to the vast amount of interesting Texas agriculture. All interns will receive a scholarship at the completion of their internship.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be an undergraduate student enrolled in a Texas college/university wanting to promote Texas agriculture to an array of audiences at one of the many Texas livestock shows and rodeos.

- At least two interns will work together each week.
- Shift hours vary by venue operational schedule.
- Lunch and morning/afternoon breaks provided.
- Interns must attend an in-person training in Waco in Fall 2026.
- Hotel rooms and meals will be provided by TFB.
- Interns will provide their own transportation to/from the venue and hotel. Mileage and gas reimbursement will not be available.
- Interns will receive a scholarship that will be sent to their university after their internship.
